Dear Dr. Samit:

On behalf of Lung Cancer Alliance (LCA), I am writing to urge Anthem Blue Cross & Blue Shield to reconsider its recent policy change in at least nine states to deny coverage of Computed Tomography (CT) and Magnetic Resonance Imaging (MRI) services performed in hospital outpatient departments. As one of the nation's leading and highest rated non-profit, since 1995 we have played a critical role in every major advance in changing how we support, talk about, detect and treat lung cancer. In this capacity, we are concerned of the potential adverse impact this policy could have on early detection efforts in the high risk population and lung cancer patients' timely access to appropriate treatment and care.

LCA's core healthcare principle is to ensure a people-centered healthcare system that works to match the right care deemed necessary by the individual and their physician. Restricting patients to specific sites of care for advanced radiologic imaging runs counter to this in several ways that are of deep concern to us.

First, restricting patient and physician choice limits access to quality care and interferes with the patient and physician's right to choose the best care options for that individual. We have already seen cases of steerage that have resulted in patients receiving poorer quality of care and sometimes repetitive testing that can increase harm risks.

Secondly, these restrictions will result in delayed care. Potential delays could occur while making arrangements from the ordering physician's site to an alternate approved site of service. Inner city and rural patients may have the hospital outpatient setting as their only immediate access point for care. Additionally, barriers to access would result if a patient was directed to a location not convenient or easily accessible to them. This policy will make completing treatment follow-up even more difficult, thus impacting outcomes. Consistency in medical care is vital to diagnosis and treatments.

Thirdly, this policy will have the chilling effect of slowing – not accelerating – the deployment of and access to a newly approved life-saving screening benefit for those at high risk for lung cancer. Only recently have the US Preventive Services Task Force and Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services recommended screening using low dose CT for a high risk populations. Lung cancer screening is in early stages of national implementation.

At the end of this letter, you will find a list of the lung cancer screening programs in our network of Screening Centers of Excellence that will feel the impact of these policies. These programs have committed to following best practice protocols, which includes connection to a multidisciplinary lung cancer clinical team.

Lung cancer is the leading cause of cancer among men and women in every state - and nationwide. An estimated 222,500 new cases of lung cancer will be diagnosed in 2017 accounting for 25% of all cancer diagnoses. As you know, timely and informed decisions on early detection and patient treatment will positively impact survival outcomes for lung cancer patients.

LCA has made it a priority to ensure that our community understands and has greater access to the best early diagnosis and treatment options that improve individualized outcomes. While we understand the concern with imaging costs, we feel the policy to redirect patients to less costly sites is short-sighted. The potential harm of diminished care access and decreased early detection under these new policies are extremely worrisome to our community. We therefore urge Anthem to work with our community to ensure patient access to these services.
