Survivor Spotlight: A Black Woman's Experience with Lung Cancer

I'm Anne Charity Hudley, Ph.D., the North Hall Endowed Chair in the Linguistics of African America and the former Director of Undergraduate Research for the Office of Undergraduate Education at the University of California, Santa Barbara. I'm also a 44-year-old married African-American woman who grew up just outside of Richmond, Virginia. My ride home from school each evening through Richmond's Shockoe Bottom area smelled like the sweet drying of leaf tobacco.



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Advocacy is Personal. This is My Story.

“Sixteen years ago, my daughter as a one-month-old baby exhibited an onset of seizures or what I remember as body jerks with painful facial grimaces. After an initial electroencephalogram (EEG), a test that detects electrical activity in her brain

At the time of the results, she was prescribed seizure medications that had only been studied in infants nine months of age and older. The lack of pediatric studies left my daughter at a disadvantage at only one month old. This is my story.”
