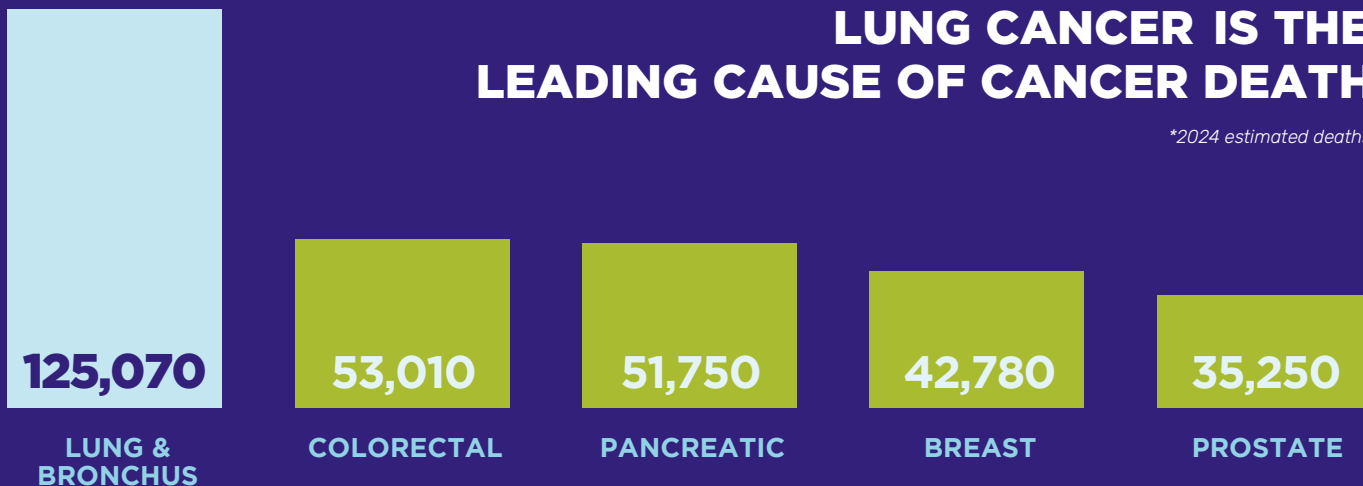

**2024 estimated deaths*



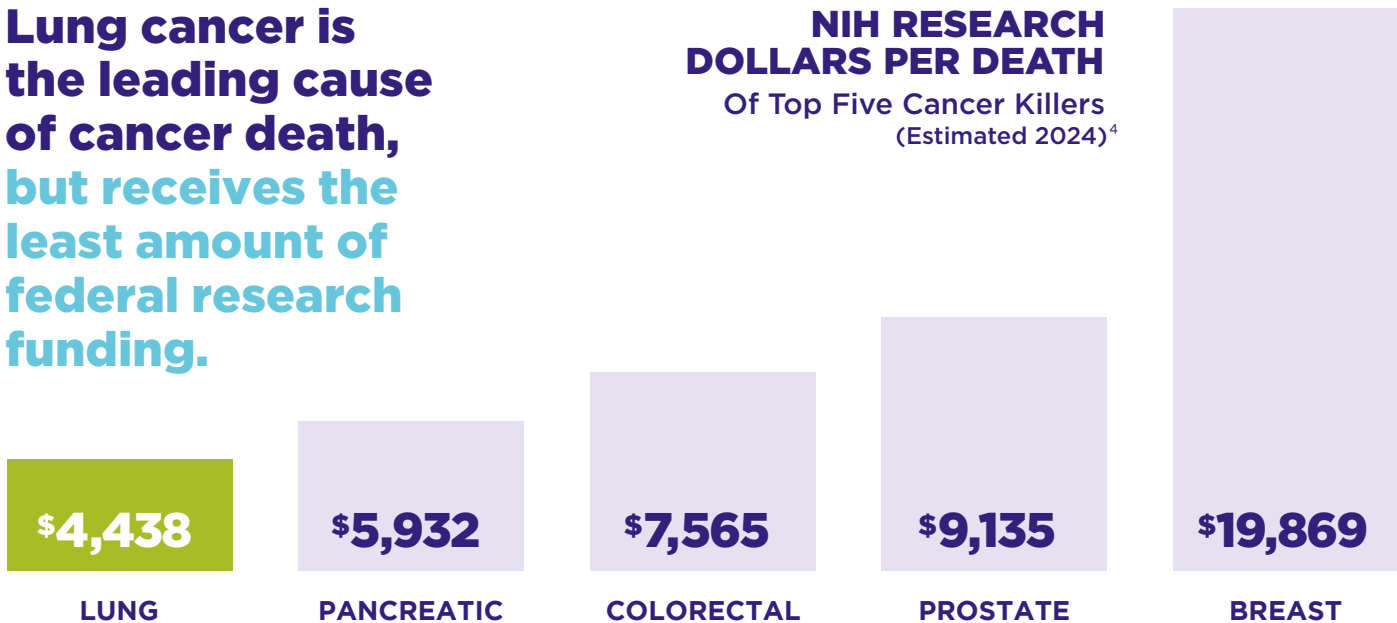

Lung cancer is the leading cause of cancer death, but receives the least amount of federal research funding.

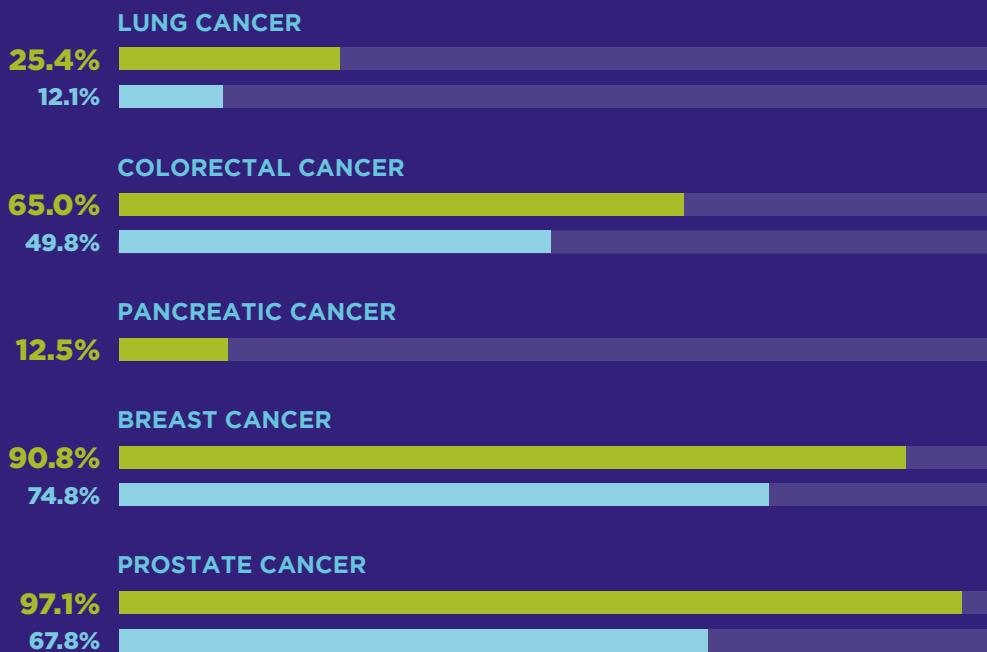
NIH RESEARCH DOLLARS PER DEATH
