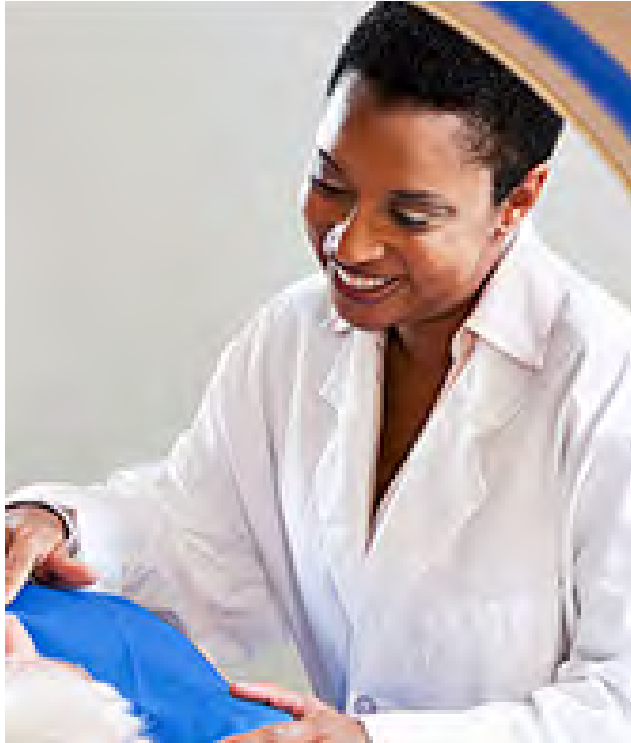

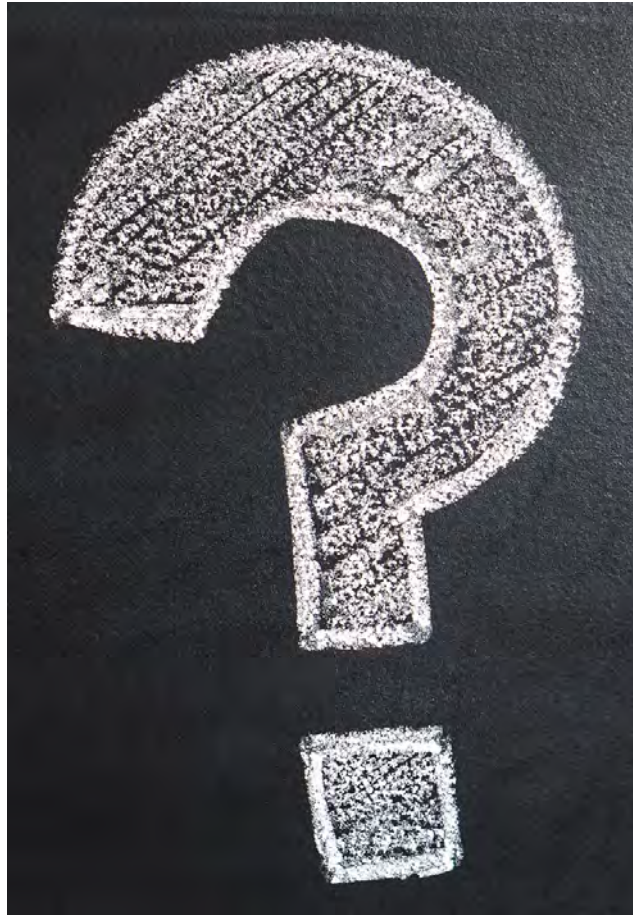
A Conversation with our Chief Scientific Officer

Q: What brought you into the cancer space?

A: Two things. I've been a math and science person since I was a little kid. As I got older I became interested in the questions behind biology, particularly genetics. I also have a lot of cancer of various types that runs in my family.



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Lung Cancer: No Silly Questions

A lung cancer diagnosis can be physically, mentally, and emotionally draining. One thing you should never worry about is asking your doctor or treatment team questions. You may feel like questions running through your head should be common sense or might be assumed—but rest assured knowing that the only silly cancer question is the one that isn't asked. A Case Study in Excellence: Southern Ohio Medical Center

Portsmouth, OH, and the surrounding region has a disproportionately high number of people diagnosed with lung cancer. The screening rate at Southern Ohio Medical Center (SOMC) is 12.28 cases per 1,000. The national average: 2.61. It's a community in stark need of great medical care. Fortunately, the people there are in luck.
