#### **POSITION SUMMARY**

The Navigator, Treatment and Trials is a member of the Science & Research team and is primarily responsible for helping direct patients with lung cancer and their loved ones to appropriate treatment options to discuss with their care teams. This position will coordinate patient enrollment and follow-up for the LungMATCH program and will help navigate patients to treatment and clinical trial options that are appropriate based on clinical characteristics and personal preferences. LungMATCH is a direct-to-patient/caregiver navigation program to ensure that everyone has access to high quality lung cancer care through education and empowerment.

The Navigator, Treatment and Trials will also help coordinate the introduction and implementation of the LungMATCH program and accompanying patient/caregiver educational materials within GO2 Foundation's community hospital partners. The Navigator should enjoy working directly with patients and caregivers and have an interest in emerging lung cancer science and research. This position will staff the Spanish telephone HelpLine and online support portal one day per week.



#### **ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS AND RESPONSIBILITIES**

- Develop broad knowledge and understanding of various types and stages of lung cancer and the corresponding treatment options, as well as molecular testing and clinical trials
- Answer phone and online questions about lung cancer treatment, comprehensive biomarker testing, and clinical trials
- Work with databases of patient treatment information, maintaining appropriate patient privacy protocols
- Interface (liaison with staff at) with GO2 Foundation's Care Continuum Centers of Excellence hospital network to help bring LungMATCH services to patients in the community
- Collaborate with marketing and other internal partners to develop and execute strategies that expand reach of the LungMATCH program and other GO2 Foundation patient education, particularly in underserved communities
- Provide direct service information and referrals to callers on GO2 Foundation's tollfree Spanish HelpLine and provide back-up to other GO2 Foundation support services
- Represent GO2 Foundation at meetings and conferences as assigned, sharing information gained with pertinent staff
- Collaborate with GO2 Foundation colleagues to identify gaps in educational materials and assist in the creation of materials
- Support LungMATCH related projects and initiatives in day-to-day functions

- Oncology experience and knowledge highly preferred but not required
